This event highlighted **Ekya Nava's leadership in reimagining education**, inspiring students to think critically, collaborate, and innovate for real-world impact.










# Inauguration of Key Spaces at Ekya Nava during FIND Festival 2024


#### Visit by Mr. Gabe Gabrielle
